- Established in 2018, the Central Jersey Chapter of Sewa International embarked on its mission to support distressed communities and families
- Initially, the focus was on cultivating volunteerism among high school-aged young adults
- Recognizing the prevalent gaps within New Jersey, particularly concerning food insecurity, the chapter sought to foster volunteerism to help those in need
- However, initiating the chapter came with its own set of challenges and risks, primarily reliant on volunteers and the commitment required to fulfill the organization's long-term strategic objectives

2020: Launch

- Mission Mask
 - 28 hospitals served in NJ, NY, PA
 - Over 10,000 hand-made masks donated
- Drive-thru PPE distribution to first responders
 - 25,000 PPE distributed
- Drive-thru food distribution to 5,000 families
- Local helpline created



Sewa International AmeriCorps programs - Child Education, Family Services, Mental Health, Environmental Justice, Disaster Preparedness, and Community Engagement.

BE CALM:

- A public health initiative funded by AmeriCorps CDC for the mental well-being of individuals
- Weekly mental health first aid training, workshops, and awareness sessions aimed at educating beneficiaries in underserved communities
- Bi-weekly yoga sessions and hiking excursions, to promote mental health awareness and well-being

ASPIRE:

- Achieving Students Progress, Instilling Resilience, and Excellence after-school program (Math, English Language Arts, and Enrichment)
- Provides supplementary language intervention and helps improve academic performance for children from kindergarten to sixth grade
- Children from underserved, refugee, and immigrant communities
- Dedicated to empowering young minds and fostering a culture of learning and growth

9/11 SERVICE DAY:

- Promote awareness and cultivate a spirit of civic responsibility
- Organize Sewa Day of Service, through the year, across cities in the US
- Mobilize volunteers for service initiatives during 9/11 week 911 Day of Service and Remembrance
- Activities include neighborhood park clean-ups, community gardening, and tree planting

Key Steps and Strategies

- Comprehend the community's needs
- Select a focus area that is both easy to implement and impactful
- Avoid trying to do everything at once. Take small, manageable steps
- Form a team of dedicated volunteers
- Initiate the program and continuously improve based on feedback and observations
- Utilize social media and other platforms for outreach
- Establish meaningful partnerships
- Develop relationships with donors interested in the focus area
- Organize fundraising events with a dedicated team
- Expand the initiative by focusing on new areas while refining existing ones
- Regularly reflect, refine, and innovate
- Celebrate successes, big or small

From Seed to Service: A SewaMeal Program

- Commenced in 2020 by assisting a family in crisis following the loss of both primary breadwinners
- Scaled up the initiative to provide 50 meals to a Homeless Shelter in Edison, NJ
- Further expansion ensued, catering to the needs of over 1000 individuals across diverse communities in Central and South Jersey, effectively combating food insecurity

From Plot to Plate: A SewaProduce Program

- Started out by offering voluntary assistance in community gardens
- Empowered young adult volunteers to utilize acquired skills to create Backyard and Bucket Gardening initiatives aimed at producing fresh produce
- Currently, contributing our harvest to Food Pantries, Soup Kitchens, Homeless Shelters, and Relief efforts
- In addition, our SewaMeal program utilizes the produce we grow
